

I'm providing this document out of my desire to help the genealogical community.

I was sent or loaned this document many years ago, but unfortunately, I cannot find any reference as to who sent it to me. Possibly by a previous Vicar of the Church.

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This is a significant body of work which has clearly taken many hours of research and documentation and I do not wish to steal the praise of the original author but rather, I feel that this document is far too important to remain in my possession only or in obscurity when it could help those in the family history community.

I am transcribing it as faithfully as I possibly can. Mistakes are possible, though it should be noted that there were some grammatical errors in the original text and in the original inscriptions.

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Type the surname and then move through the records till you find your relatives. Good luck.
